# **FAQ** for Reopening

## Which programs are open to patrons, as of the June 22 reopening?

The Sunset Pool will be open 11am-4pm for lap swim and gym use. Six spots will be available per hour in the lap pool and five spots available in the fitness room.

#### Do I need a reservation?

Reservations will be required, on a first come, first served basis. ### How long can I work out?

Patrons will be admitted to our facility on the hour and will be checked in by staff before entering the pool or gym areas. Patrons can work out for 45 minutes, and then will need to leave so staff can sanitize equipment for the next group to use.

#### Will locker rooms be available?

Locker rooms are available and have been modified for social distancing. We encourage patrons to come in workout clothes and swimmers to come in suits to minimize the time needed in locker rooms. Swimmers are still required to shower before entering the pool and will need to be showered and dressed within their 45 minute session if they plan to use the locker rooms.

#### Do I need to wear a mask?

Patrons will be strongly encouraged to wear a mask for all activities that can be completed with a mask and while patrons spend time in shared spaces.

## What is SEPRD doing to keep patrons safe?

All patrons will be asked to complete health safety screening information and will be asked to practice social distancing. Staff will sanitize work out areas and equipment between sessions, as well as at other times throughout the day, following guidance from the Oregon Health Authority. SEPRD will also use signage and other resources to help with traffic flow.

## Can I bring my family to swim?

We ask that patrons make reservations for any member of their family who wishes to swim. At the current time, only lap swim is available. As SEPRD moves to the next phase of reopening, we hope to offer open swim opportunities.
